



As we approach Spring, we'll soon see Pictona 2 spring out of the ground as the workers erect our twostory Pictona Training Center and the Stadium hosting our championship court. As construction progresses on the \$6 million addition to Pictona, we now are focused on all the furniture and equipment needed in the facility. Bleachers, tables and chairs, office furniture, and computers and communication equipment will need to be purchased. A second Player Shop will be stocked. A large concession wing needs to be equipped. Windscreens for the 5 new covered courts are needed. We'd like a digital scoreboard for the championship court. We will need hundreds of thousands of dollars to purchase all the equipment.

Recently we received a \$5000 donation from Keith and Katy Kelly, an unsolicited gift, to help equip Pictona 2. We thank the Kelly's for their generosity and will be placing a paddle in their honor on our Friends of Pictona wall located on the Palace.

On **Tuesday Feb. 22 at 5 PM** the NSB Parks and Recreation Dept will hold a preliminary budget meeting. We currently have 5 dedicated Pickleball courts and will make our case for 6 new courts.
