► Located in the Daytona area, Pictona at Holly Hill is one of the largest dedicated pickleball facilities in Florida. The \$6.3 million venue opened in July 2020 and boasts 24 LED lighted courts, including eight that are covered, a center pavilion, restaurant, clubhouse and game room. Pictona also provides a wide variety of programming for youth and adults, competitive tournaments, and plenty of social events.

This year, the facility will double in size. Pictona 2 broke ground last October and is slated for completion this October.



Pictona Recognized

Pictona was named the **Pickleball Municipal Facility of the Year** by Tennis Industry Magazine in its April issue. NIDY, the company that built the courts, nominated Pictona for this award. Holly Hill City Manager, Joe Forte, commented in the article that "Pictona is putting Holly Hill on the map nationially among pickleball enthusiasts. We have people calling the Holly Hill Chamber asking for information about homes in the area because they want to relocate near Pictona."

After more than a year of planning and underground work, Pictona 2 springs out of the ground with two large concrete block towers. They are the stairwells for the twostory Pictona Training Center. And we now see the erection of the steel framework for the covered courts, an expanse of 26,320 sf, providing protection for the championship court with seating for 1200 and 4 additional courts.
