


Time to get your Pickleball Rating!

We are happy to announce the Pictona Instructor David Heinze has developed the "Pictona Skill Assessment Program" (PSA) which will assign a rating to a player based on watching them play. Unlike other pickleball rating systems, the PSA determines your ratings by assessing your actual skills as opposed to only game results. Having this rating will not only allow a player to appropriately place themselves in leveled events, but will give them a roadmap for improvement. Each player that is rated will receive a report which will identify areas of strengths and weaknesses.

There is an Information Session scheduled for **Wednesday**, **August 3 6-7pm in the Senior Activity Center**. Here Dave Heinze will talk about the rating system, describe the process, demonstrate how it is done, and answer any questions you may have.
