



#### WHEN WE ASK...

When we announce that lightning has been detected within 10 miles of Pictona and you are asked to come into the clubhouse or the covered courts, don't give our Managers on Duty a hard time about doing so. You must immediately stop playing on the outdoor courts and the Pavilion. When we ask you to do so, we are not really asking. You must quit playing immediately. Please appreciate that our Managers on Duty are doing their "duty" to keep you safe.

#### WHEN YOU ASKED ...

... if we would permit members to exit the southeast gate by court 17, rather than it being only an emergency exit gate, we said YES we would do so. But it was not to be an entrance. Most members have respected that use of the gate, but occasionally a member will hold the gate open for people to enter. Why do people do this? Some are avoiding paying the entry fee. Others are members and they justify their action by saying the walk around to the north side is just too much! Yet they will play pickleball for the next two hours. Understand that when people defeat our access control system by not checking in at the Welcome Desk it cheats Pictona. We ask that all members use this gate as an exit only and that when you see someone entering that way, you tell them to enter the correct way. We cannot have a Manager on Duty patrolling this gate constantly. Alternatively, we will have to once again make this an emergency gate.

#### AND WE ASK AGAIN ...

You are not to enter the courts by passing through the Kitchen. Some do so to avoid paying. Some do so and then check in at the Welcome Desk. We ask again that everyone when first coming to Pictona check in by entering on the north side, not through the Kitchen.

We will appreciate you following these procedures and cooperating with Pictona's employees who work to provide you with an exceptional place to play.
