World Pickleball Tour at Pictona This Weekend!

The World Pickleball Tour is a strictly amateur tournament series that hosted 25 events in 2022 and is hosting nearly 40 in 2023.

All of their tournament stops are considered "challenger" events, as all Gold Medalists from our circuit are invited to the 2024 WPT Amateur Invitational Championships, which will pit the best amateur players in the country against each other as they compete for their share of the \$175,000 CASH PURSE at the event, which will be held right here at Pictona!



Why Should You Buy Safety Glasses for Pickleball?

As pickleball players, we invest in things that protect our knees, elbows, and wrists. We wear sunscreen to protect ourselves from the sun, and we have our favorite pickleball shoes to protect our feet from damage.

The item that I see many players forget is eye protection. I am one of those players who never really gave it a second thought until just a few weeks ago when a ball glanced off a paddle and hit one of my friends in the eye. She went down immediately and luckily did not have any damage after being checked out by her eye doctor.

Then just a few days later I was sitting on the bleachers, and a stray ball whizzed right past my eye. That was it for me, I ordered eye protection glasses. The players in my group have ordered them as well.

According to a recent Article in Pickleball Magazine, "Racket sports rank 4th among activities causing eye injuries. About 90% of these could be avoided with the use of protective eyewear made of polycarbonate lenses."

No sense in taking a chance; let's be safe out there and protect our eyes!




Boost Your Immunity
