# World Pickleball Tour - That's a Wrap!

Pictona hosted our first National Tournament of 2023 on January 13-15. The World Pickleball Tour chose Pictona as their first stop in their 20 city tour. Although the competition started off with a rainy, cold weekend, the 464 participants were excited to be participating in this 3 day event. The players ranged in age from 9 to 78. While the WPT had some difficulty with the scheduling of matches on Friday and Saturday, the tournament ran very smoothly on Sunday.

Alex Horn, WPT executive, stated: "All of the tour stops are considered "challenger" events, and the Gold Medalists from each tournament are invited to participate in the 2024 WPT Amateur National Championships. This exciting tournament will pit the best amateur players in the country against each other as they compete for their share of the \$175,000 CASH PURSE at the event.

### East Gate Entrance is OPEN - For Members Only

At last you may now enter Pictona using the East Gate which is most convenient when parking in the East lot. Here's how it works:

- By the single gate is a post with a button and video camera.
- Press the button which will signal the Pictona 2 Welcome Desk.
- You'll be asked for your membership number and your image will be matched to the image on file.
- As a member you'll hear the gate release and you may enter.
- You may be asked to report to the Welcome Desk if your membership needs to be renewed, otherwise you may go directly to the courts.
- When exiting push the button on the post near the gate to release it.

## This entrance is not for individuals purchasing day passes or using the 10-pass card.



# Action Around the Campus

You may notice we're making significant improvements in and around the Pictona Campus.

- We've added a second dumpster station by the East Gate. *(We produce a lot of trash!)*
- Replacement of the net posts on courts 1-8 so they remain vertical.
- Replacement of the LED lights on courts 1-8, as they've malfunctioned.
- Improvement of the ground surface for exhibitors along the road between Pictona 1 and 2.
- Sealing the concrete around the championship court.
- Purchasing a second layer of protection for the championship court when used for performances.
- Installation of curtains around the MetroHealth Stadium to protect the courts from wind and rain and to eliminate the backlight problem in seeing the ball.

We have other enhancements that we would like to pursue, but we'll first complete the above list.



## Audio / Video Coordinator

We're looking for a part-time person to manage our audio and video activities, especially with tournaments and other special events. During tournaments the duties are (1) to set up and operate our audio system, (2) to serve as a DJ making announcements, playing music during timeouts and between games and matches, and (3) assisting others who need audio access.

The position will also oversee our championship court scoreboard and promotional TVs as well as live streaming play to our TV monitors throughout the Pictona Campus.

A qualified candidate will have experience with audio and video, be an articulate and energetic announcer, and have the flexibility to work all day during tournaments with plenty of time off between events.






