### **Member Factoid**

Our membership income (monthly and annual) for 2023 was \$461,000. Our daily pass income was \$192,000, a total of \$653,000 revenue for ACCESS to Pictona for the year. Our membership income is 70% of our access income and the daily pass income represents 30%. Our annual income was \$2,237,000. Our Membership income represents 20% of the total revenue that sustains Pictona.

Tournaments and Sponsorship are the two additional major sources of revenue, followed by the Kitchen, Player Shops, and Education.
